



LEARNING DIARY


DATE: 06/11/2023

Today we learned something new about safety, especially about safety in public places. When we talk about safety in public places, we divide people into two groups, service providers and service users. For the service user, service providers must design: safe design (accessibility, lights), clear signs, maintenance, cleanliness, crime prevention (security patrol), emergency response (evacuation guide, first aid).

The feeling of safety in public spaces is important, and it is achieved through easy accessibility, clear signs and instructions, cleanliness, the availability of first aid and so on.

We also learned what SWOT means. SWOT analysis is a framework for identifying and analyzing an organization's strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats. These words make up the SWOT acronym. The primary goal of SWOT analysis is to increase awareness of the factors that go into making a business decision or establishing a business strategy.

We also had conversations with disabled people. Our group had a conversation with deaf people and two disabled people in wheelchairs. Each of them has problems that we do not face and cannot identify with. It is interesting that they have problems with things that seem everyday to us, for example deaf people communicate with gestures and therefore need to watch each other, if they talk while walking it can be dangerous for them if they are not paying attention to the things around them.

We also tried what it's like to be old with a walker and moved around the location a bit.
