
















#### Theme

Communities, inherently delicate and subject to external and internal changes, often struggle to embrace and adapt to evolving circumstances. Those situated in urban locales face perpetual challenges arising from rapid urban regeneration, shifts in lifestyle, economic fluctuations, and migration dynamics. The relentless pace of modern life, coupled with societal norms and values, exerts pressure on community members. The resilience of communities hinges on addressing the vulnerabilities within, as marginalized individuals weaken the fabric of local communities. By enhancing the quality of life for vulnerable groups through greater integration, accessibility, and safety, we not only fortify communities but also foster a more harmonious, compassionate, and tolerant environment.

#### \_Challenge

Can our interdisciplinary group of scholars and future experts identify, highlight, and propose necessary changes? We aim to delve into various aspects of vulnerable groups and accessibility, encompassing physical accessibility, active citizenship, service access, aging, urban poverty, violence and abuse, urban migration, addiction, inequality, and health. Our exploration will focus on the neighboring areas of the Faculty of Architecture in Ljubljana, including residential neighborhoods and central areas (such as the old city center, Prule, and Trnovo). Subsequently, we will seek solutions through municipal policy adjustments, long-term strategies, planning, design, and innovative approaches.

#### Format and Timeframe

Over the course of five days, from Monday, February 12, to Friday, February 17, 2024, we will rise to the challenge. Initial days will involve expert lectures, site visits, group formation, moderated discussions, and exploration. The latter part of our collaborative effort will be dedicated to international, interdisciplinary group work, culminating in the presentation of proposals and solutions.
